

The Choice Adviser will be available to meet with parents/carers to offer one to one advice and support to help them make the best and most realistic choices for their child.

The Choice Adviser will also visit schools, attend information sessions, talks with parent groups, open days/ evenings etc.



We specialise in helping with the transfer from primary to high schools but can provide information about nursery, infant, junior and primary schools, including the arrangements for the admission of pupils. We also work with the local Parent Partnership Service.

The Schools Choice Adviser is available to offer advice and act as an independent advocate, when a young person has been, or is at risk of being, excluded from school.

The Choice Adviser can provide clear information that is easy to understand to help you come to a decision including:

- * **How the transfer and admission system works**
- * **Information about schools**
- * **Admission policies and criteria for different schools**
- * **Transport, uniform and any other issues**

The Choice Adviser will not take decisions for parents and cannot guarantee a place at a particular school but by providing advice, support and information, the service aims to place all families on a level playing field to make sure every child gets the best possible start in school.
